Dermatopathology Differential Diagnosis Acantholysis

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Must Know Diseases

| Disease | Differentiating Traits |
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| Darier's disease | Prominent parakeratosis above corp ronds and grains |
| Grover's disease | Multiple patterns of acantholysis (Darier's, Hailey-Hailey, pemphigus) and spongiosis |
| Hailey-Hailey disease | Majority of epidermis involved by acantholysis |
| Herpes virus infection | Ballooning degeneration, multinucleated cells with chromatin margination |
| Pemphigus foliaceus | Granular prominent with acantholysis |
| Pemphigus vulgaris | Acantholysis above tombstoned basal layer, follicles may be involved |
| Squamous cell carcinoma, adenoid type | Acantholysis and squamous pearls, atypical keratinocytes and mitoses |
| Warty dyskeratoma | Cup-shaped area of acantholytic dyskeratosis, villi at base |
