- Acrodermatitis chronica atrophicans
- Leishmania
- Parvovirus B19 infection

Inflammatory Conditions

- Scleroderma
- Eosinophilic myalgia syndrome
- Shulman's syndrome
- Sarcoidosis
- Behcet's disease
- Degos' disease

Malignant Conditions

- Marker of perineural invasion in cutaneous malignancies
- Lymphoproliferative disorders (esp CLL)
