Hidroacanthoma Simple

- This is an example of acanthosis nigricans.
- The histopathological changes are subtly different from a seborrheic keratosis with less of a “stuck-on” flattened rete ridge pattern and slight papillomatosis
- Ultimately, clinical correlation may be necessary
