Notes

- Classical descriptions of eruptive xanthomas include a proliferation of foamy histiocytes with lymphocytes and neutrophils
- However, there remains considerable histopathologic overlap with conventional xanthomas
- Ultimately, this is a clinical-pathologic correlation.
- This patient had a classic eruptive xanthoma.

Numerous foamy histiocytes
